The board meetings have been changed to the second Wednesday of the month at 6:00 pm. Members are always welcome.



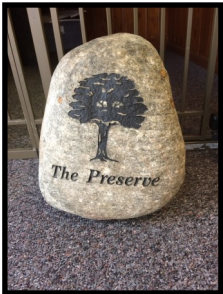
DIY Sign Making Class:

Update on the Preserve Boulevard Reconstruction Project:

Construction is expected to start early this spring and be completed by the fall of this year. Some of the project improvements include; the addition of a second southbound lane on Preserve Boulevard at the intersection of Anderson Lakes Pkwy, the addition of left turn lanes at all intersections, landscaped medians with improved pedestrian facilities, and the addition of a storm water pump station to pump water from Eden Lake to Neill Lake to help control water levels during heavy rain. The project includes the intersection of Preserve Boulevard and Prairie Center Drive south through the Anderson Lakes Parkway intersection with storm water work extending to Neill Lake.
