Buckthorn: our grounds crew has been very busy removing buckthorn and planning for replanting.

<u>Watershed grant:</u> We have applied for a Stewardship Grant from the Riley Purgatory Bluff Creek Watershed District. This will cover 75% of our cost of planting native grasses and flowers around the pool where the Japanese Knotweed had taken over as well as transforming the grassy area near the brush pile into a natural habitat and pollinator garden.
