UPDATES:

Ligularia Plants: We are giving away a limited number of plants on October 10th from 10-12pm. Please contact The Preserve by October 9th to arrange pick up if you are interested in a plant or two. These perennial plants grow to three feet tall and three feet wide. The large purple tinged foliage topped with bright yellow flowers of Ligularia have a dramatic effect in a part-shade or shade garden and attract pollinators such as bees and butterflies.



Grant: We have been selected to receive a Cost Share Grant from the Riley Purgatory Bluff Creek Watershed. It will allow us to plant prairie grasses and flowers around the Dive Well where the Japanese Knot weed was removed. We will also be transforming the 19,000 SF of lawn south of the path near the volleyball court into a native grass and flower area. 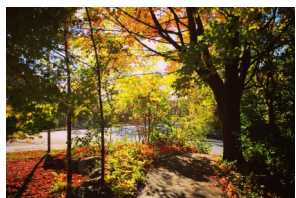
