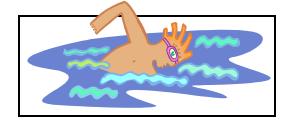

If you are new to pickleball they would appreciate you reading up on the rules before attending. Nets are provided and a limited number of racquets are available for use. Balls are provided.







Preserve neighborhood upkeep depends on each resident doing

their part in being a good neighbor by adhering to the rules and regulations of The Preserve. These are provided when you purchase your property and are available on our website. The Board and staff help you do this by our design review process which ensures that the standards identified in our Covenants for improvements, additions, landscaping and general remodeling of individual properties are met.

Here are some excerpts from Preserve Rules and guidelines:

-Trash, yard waste and recycling containers <u>may not be stored outside</u> in the open, but must be stored inside the garage or screened from public view. This is <u>also a city code</u>.

-There are nearly 200 acres of common property in the Preserve. Please do not dump refuge or yard waste into these areas or allow your yard to encroach into these areas. However, if you would like to improve or maintain the common areas by picking up trash, pulling buckthorn, invasive weeds, or removing brush etc., contact the office and we will be delighted to work with you.

-All yard debris must be disposed of within one week and may not be piled up or kept on private property or dumped on Preserve common property. This is <u>also a city code</u>.

* Note: All trash haulers provide unlimited yard waste service for a small fee. When people place their yard waste on Preserve property it costs us all. Working together as neighbors we can maintain property values in our neighborhoods.



Private/Semi-Private Swim Lessons

Private and Semi-Private swim lessons are available with Preserve Water Safety Instructors. Lessons are for children, teens and adults of all ages and ability levels. If you want to request a certain instructor from our staff, please do so at the time of registration. Semi-Private Lessons are for 2 students of equal ability and may be from separate families.
