The pool will open weekends (Saturday/Sunday) starting Memorial Day Weekend (to include Monday, May 30). It will open daily starting Tuesday, June 14 at noon for the season. Pool tags are now available for members at the Preserve Center. All association members <u>must</u> pick up new tags each year to gain admission to the pool and the tennis courts. Guests accompanying Preserve members pay a fee of \$3 per child under age 18 and \$5 for adults.

Each <u>nine-lesson</u> session runs Monday through Friday in week one and Monday through Thursday in week two. This allows for a makeup class on the last Friday if needed. The city swim sessions are for eight classes.

Class fee: \$62 per session for members \$70 per session for non-members
