<u>Lifeguards:</u> The Preserve Pool is a wonderful place to work and a great summer job. Now accepting applications for WSI's and lifeguards. All lifeguards must have a Red Cross Lifeguard Certificate. Training is available through EPHS and counts as a PE credit.

POOL SEASON 2021

The pool will open Memorial Weekend- Saturday, May 29, 2021 through Labor Day. The Pool ID cards are permanent and will be available for members at the Preserve. POOL CARDS ARE KEPT FROM YEAR TO YEAR and are \$15.00 each to replace. All association members <u>must</u> pick up cards to gain admission to the pool and the tennis courts. Guests accompanying Preserve members pay a fee of \$3 per child under age 18 and \$5 for adults.

Children 3 thru Pre-kindergarten 5 years old will be in the *Preschool Aquatic* Program. Ages kindergarten/5 year old's and up will be in the *Learn to Swim* Program. Full details online or at the office on swim lesson policies.

Each <u>nine-lesson</u> session runs Monday through Friday in week one and Monday through Thursday in week two. This allows for a makeup class on the last Friday if needed (Make-up only if classes cancelled for 2 weather related days).

Class fee: \$80 per session for members/\$105 per session for non-members

Registration: Priority to Preserve members beginning April 1. May 1, 2021 open to the general public.

Updates

- Dead Fish along Neill Lake: we have received some concern about the dead fish along Neill Lake. This is a normal result of Winterkill. When snow and ice cover a lake, they limit the sunlight reaching aquatic plants. When the plants die from lack of sunlight, they start to decompose, a process which uses oxygen in the water.
