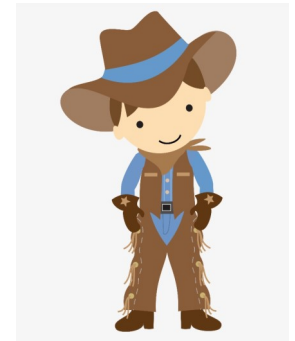

Join us for an adult gathering in the Adult Beach Area

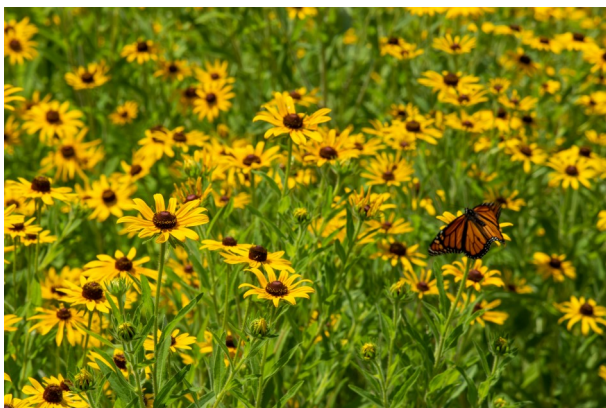
