Children 3 thru Pre-kindergarten 5 years old will be in the *Preschool Aquatic* Program. Ages kindergarten/ 5 year old's and up will be in the *Learn to Swim* Program. Full details online or at the office on swim lesson policies.

Each <u>nine-lesson</u> session runs Monday through Friday in week one and Monday through Thursday in week two. This allows for a makeup class on the last Friday if needed (Make-up only if classes cancelled for 2 weather related days).

tournaments including being a Gold Medalist at 4.5/4.0 Women's Doubles at the 2019 USAPA Midstate's Regionals, a Gold Medalist at 4.0 Women's Singles at the 2018 USAPA Midstate's Regionals, and last December playing 4.0 Women's Doubles at the 2021 National USAPA tournament. Rae is an enthusiastic instructor with a keen eye to improving individual play in a group setting. Last year was the first year The Preserve offered pickleball programs. With the increased demand, the program is expanding for this summer.
