Build Your Own Rain Barrel Work Shop

Wednesday, May 22, 5:30 pm

Join the RPBCWD for a Build Your Own Rain Barrel workshop at The Preserve. Rain barrels help reduce the amount of runoff flowing across your property by capturing and storing rainwater from your roof, which can then be reused to water your garden or irrigate your lawn. This workshop will walk you through how to convert a retired oak wine barrel into a beautiful rain barrel of your very own.

Please be aware that barrels are used and may have visual imperfections (this adds to the charm!)

Workshop attendees must be residents of The Preserve. Limit 1 barrel per household, though you may bring a friend or family member to help put together your barrel.

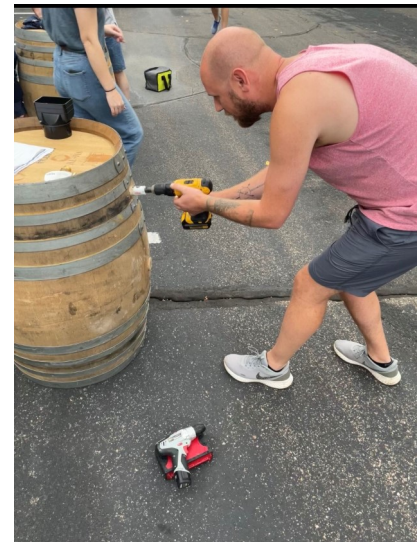
Note: Barrels are heavy - over 100 pounds - and attendees are responsible for transporting their barrel home with them after the workshop.

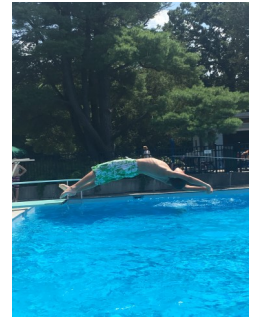

American Red Cross Preschool Aquatics and Learn-to-Swim Program

Best outdoor swim lessons in Town!

Children 4 thru Pre-kindergarten 5 years old will be in the *Preschool Aquatic* Program. Ages kindergarten/ 5 year old's and up will be in the *Learn to Swim* Program. Full details online or at the office on swim lesson policies. Each nine-lesson session runs Monday through Friday in week one and Monday through Thursday in week two. This allows for a makeup class on the last Friday if needed (Make-up only if classes cancelled for 2 weather related days) .

Class fee: \$100 per session for members/\$125 per session for non-members

Registration: Priority to Preserve members beginning April 1. April 15, 2024 open to the general public.
